After an initial consultation whereby the needs of the school were discussed we quickly got to work to produce a number of designs, (few of the designs are shown below) that incorporated the best learning and play opportunities for the school community that would be set in a natural environment. A second consultation led to a decision that we would commence with the actual works as soon as possible. The works were eventually completed over three stages spanning nine months, and Platt Bridge Community School now has the complete learning experience for its children.
