TIP:
Once established try not to disturb it...

Bees love bunches of straw, dry sticks and dead wood. They use it for burrowing. If you don't have enough, add to the layers when you have more

Bundles of bamboo canes are one of the best ways to attract bugs, including solitary Bees. Up turned plant pots are a favourite for Queen Bees

Fill some sacks with compost, cut holes in the sides, and grow nectar rich plants for passing butterflies, or grow strawberries for passing humans



TIP:
Place your HQ under a tree or next to a sheltered wall.

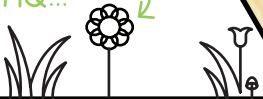
TIP:
Grow wildflowers around the HQ...

Drill holes into the ends of large logs. Combine them with stacks of roof tiles and you'll create attractive and functional habitat

Fill this section with your largest items like logs, rocks, clay drain pipes etc. Add some damp leaves too, perfect for frogs and toads

Dry leaves, bark pieces and fir cones are ideal for all sorts of insects. Make a range of nooks for bugs to shelter in by piling up rolls of hessian

TIP:
Pile some rotten logs around the base.
